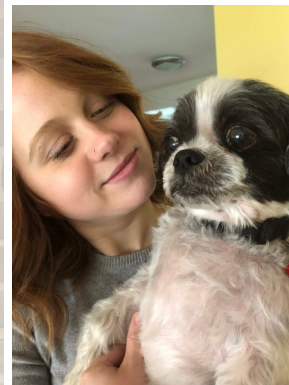

Spring Sports Update

Baseball's a GO, 6th Graders CAN Play, But We Don't Have Enough Girls For Softball

Sports are returning to Wilkinson Middle School for ALL students this spring and we'd love for your student to join us.

These teams will be open to both in-person and virtual learners enrolled at Wilkinson Middle School.



Practices begin April 19, and games on May 4. To participate, students must first turn in a recent and completed physical form, signed by a medical professional. The physical form must be from the 2020-21 school year (August, 2020 or later).

Athletes will follow existing health and safety protocols, established by the district.

These protocols mirror the existing student protocols for in-person learning, including:

- Weekly COVID rapid tests
- Daily health screenings, prior to entering campus.

- Updated emergency contact information.
- Facemask requirement
- Pick up and mitigation protocols for students with illness symptoms
- Ability to provide your own transportation home from practices / games.

Expansion of In-Person Learning Begins April 19

State Testing Update

Wilkinson Middle School students are scheduled to begin our annual standardized state testing, next month.

Testing begins Tuesday, April 13, with the PSAT 8 exam. This is a multi-hour exam and will require the entire staff to support. On 4/13, all grade 6 and grade 7 students will stay home and learn asynchronously.
